An Act to amend the Registration of Business Names Act, 1928.

[Assented to, November 15th, 1932.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Registration of Business Names Act Amendment Act, 1932". Short titles.

(2) The Registration of Business Names Act, 1928 (which is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Registration of Business Names Acts, 1928 and 1932". No. 1851 of 1928.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph (b) thereof the following paragraph:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Registration.

(c) every corporation having a place of business in South Australia and carrying on business under a business name which does not consist of its corporate name without any addition,

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end of paragraph (f) of subsection (1) thereof the words "in South Australia". Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—
Particulars of registration.

4. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended— Amendment of principal Act, s. 15—
Payment of fees,

(a) by inserting after the word "particulars" second occurring in the second line thereof the passage "(whether a notice requiring such particulars has been given under section 13 or not)"; and

(b) by inserting after the word "Act" in the fourth line thereof the words "or shall without reasonable excuse fail, upon furnishing any such statement, to pay to the Registrar the fee prescribed therefor".

Amendment of
principal Act—

5. The principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section 22 the following section:—

Removal from
Register.

22A. The Registrar may remove from the Register the name of any corporation registered under this Act the name of which has been struck off any register of companies kept under the Companies Act, 1892.

Amendment of
principal Act—

6. The principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section 23 the following section:—

Evidentiary
provisions.

23A. In any proceedings for an offence against this Act, if proof is given that any business name is displayed on any premises, and evidence is given from which the Court may infer that the business name has reference to any business carried on in such premises, the firm or person carrying on such business shall, in the absence of proof to the contrary, be deemed to be carrying on such business under such business name.
