An Act to amend the Registration of Business Names Act, 1928-1955.

[Assented to 9th November, 1961.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Registration of Business Names Act Amendment Act, 1961".
- (2) The Registration of Business Names Act, 1928-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Registration of Business Names Act, 1928-1961".
- (3) The Registration of Business Names Act, 1928-1955, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Enactment of s. 4a of principal Act3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 4 thereof:—

Use of business name in invitations to the public to make deposits or loans prohibited. 4a. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, where a firm, individual or corporation carrying on business in South Australia under a business-name is registered or required to be registered under this Act in relation to that business-name, no person shall use or make reference to that business-name in any invitation to the public, or in any advertisement inviting the public, to deposit money with or lend money to that firm, individual or corporation.

Penalty: Five hundred pounds.

- (2) This section does not affect any provision of the Companies Act, 1934-1960.
