An Act to amend the Rundle Street Mall Act, 1975.

[Assented to 18th November, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Rundle Street Mall Act Amendment Act, 1976".

(2) The Rundle Street Mall Act, 1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Rundle Street Mall Act, 1975-1976".

Interpretation.

2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from the definition of "the Committee" the word "Street".

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the passage "Rundle Street Mall" the passage "and, on and after the commencement of the Rundle Street Mall Act Amendment Act, 1976, to be known as the 'Rundle Mall'";

and

(b) by inserting after the present contents, as amended by this section (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) Where immediately before the appointed day, the address of any place or premises was specified by reference to that part of Rundle Street which on and from that day was established as the Rundle Street Mall that specification shall, for all purposes continue to be a sufficient specification of that address.

4. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "Not less than one hundred dollars and not more than two hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Two hundred dollars".

5. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "six" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "eight".

6. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

By-laws.
(1a) A by-law made under subsection (1) of this section may confer a function upon or provide for the exercise of a power by the Committee or any officer or employee of the Committee.
7. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the word "three" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "four".

Grant by Treasurer.
8. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (1) after the passage "shall be established" the passage "and on and after the commencement of the Rundle Street Mall Act Amendment Act, 1976, the Committee shall be known as the 'Rundle Mall Committee'".

9. Section 25 of the principal Act is amended—

Power of Council to delegate.
(a) by striking out paragraph (b) from subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—
(b) any power conferred by by-law made under section 11 of this Act; ;
and
(b) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "or function" twice occurring.
