An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974.

[Assented to 8th August, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1974".

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974".

2. Section 44 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "a member of the police force or any officer of a council in the execution of his duty under this Act or any other Act" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "any person acting in the exercise or discharge of any power or duty conferred or imposed upon him under this Act or any other Act".
