An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1963.

[Assented to 15th October, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act short titles. Amendment Act, 1964".
- (2) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1963, as amended by this Act may be cited as the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1964.
- (3) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1963, is hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of s. 162b of principal Act principal Act after section 162a thereof:—

162b. A person shall not offer for sale or for hire a motor sale of vehicle (other than a tractor), or a trailer, the unladen re-grooved tyres. weight of which motor vehicle or trailer is less than three tons, which is fitted with a tyre that has been re-grooved.

Penalty: Twenty pounds.
