An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1934-1943.

[Assented to 31st August, 1944.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act, 1944". Short titles.

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1943, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1934-1944".

(3) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1943, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 9a of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "forty-four" therein and inserting in lieu thereof "forty-five". Amendment of s. 9a of principal Act—Temporary reduction of registration fee.
