An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1934-1945.

[Assented to 30th August, 1946.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1946 ".
- (2) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1945, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1934-1946".
- (3) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1945, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 9a of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out the word "forty-six" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-seven".

Temporary reduction of registration fee.

4. Section 27a of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out the word "forty-six" therein and inserting in lieu thereof principal Act the word "forty-seven".

Temporary reduction of fees for trader's plates.
