An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974.

[Assented to 5th December, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act (No. 5), 1974".

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1961-1974".

Interpretation.

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "traffic lights" the following definition:—

"traffic speed analyser" means an apparatus of a kind approved by the Governor as a traffic speed analyser:.

3. The following heading and section are enacted and inserted in the principal Act immediately after section 53 thereof:—

*Traffic Speed Analysers*

53a. (1) The Governor may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, approve apparatus of a specified kind as traffic speed analysers.

(2) The Governor may, by subsequent notice, vary or revoke any notice under this section.

4. Section 147 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (4) the word “January” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “July”;

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (5) the word “January” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “July”.

5. Section 175 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (ba) of subsection (3) the word “electronic” wherever it occurs.
