An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act 1961; and to make a related amendment to the Motor Vehicles Act 1959.

[Assented to 17 December 1998]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Road Events) Amendment Act 1998.
- (2) The Road Traffic Act 1961 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 23-Stop signs exhibited by authorised persons

- 3. Section 23 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:
 - (2a) A person who is authorised in the prescribed manner to do so may exhibit a stop sign for the purpose of requiring drivers to stop before entering a part of a road closed to traffic under section 33.;
- (b) by inserting after paragraph (b) of subsection (4) the following paragraph:
 - (c) to exhibit a stop sign for the purpose referred to in subsection (2a) if the Minister has authorised the person to do so.;
- (c) by inserting sfter subsection (4) the following subsection:
 - (5) An authorisation under this section may be subject to conditions, including conditions as to the wearing of identification or uniforms (or both).

Amendment of s. 78—Duties at stop signs

- 4. Section 78 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting after subsection (2b) the following subsection:
 - (2c) While a stop sign is exhibited by a person for the purpose of requiring drivers to stop before entering a part of a road closed to traffic under section 33, a driver proceeding towards the face of the sign must not permit the vehicle, or any part of the vehicle, to pass the point at which the sign is exhibited.;
- (b) by striking out from subsection (3) "elsewhere than at an intersection, junction, level crossing, pedestrian crossing or a part of a road on or near which workers are engaged or road works are in progress" and substituting "otherwise than as referred to in a preceding provision of this section".

SCHEDULE

Amendment of Motor Vehicles Act 1959

Schedule 3 of the *Motor Vehicles Act 1959* is amended by inserting in the table in Part 1 after the entry relating to section 20(4) the following entries:

Section 33(9)	Driver failing to comply with direction of a member of the police force	3
Section 34(4)	Driver failing to comply with direction of a member of the police force	3
