An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act 1961.

[Assented to 28 November 1991]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Safety Helmet Exemption) Amendment Act 1991*.

(2) The *Road Traffic Act 1961* is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

Safety helmets

2. Section 162c of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (3) the following subsection:

(4) This section does not apply to or in relation to a person who rides, rides on or is carried on a pedal cycle where that person—

(a) is of the Sikh religion;

and

(b) is wearing a turban.
