An Act to amend the Stamp Act Further Amendment Act, 1916.

*[Assented to, November 1st, 1917.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as "Stamp Act Further Amendment Act, 1917." Short titles.

(2) The Stamp Acts, 1886 to 1916, and this Act may be cited together as "Stamp Acts, 1886 to 1917."

**2.** Section 21 of the Stamp Act Further Amendment Act, 1916, is repealed. Repeal of Act 1244, 1916, s. 21—  
Duration of amusements duty.
