An Act to amend the Surveyors Act, 1935-1948.

[Assented to 10th November, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Surveyors Act Amendment Act, 1949".
- (2) The Surveyors Act, 1935-1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Surveyors Act, 1935-1949".
- (3) The Surveyors Act, 1935-1948, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, 8, 47— Regulations.

- 2. Section 47 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by inserting after paragraph XVII. of subsection (1) thereof the following paragraph:—

xvIIa. For prescribing fees which licensed surveyors shall be entitled to charge from the persons employing them:

(b) by striking out the number "xvII." in the first line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the number "xvIIa.".

Amendment of third schedule of principal Act.

3. The third schedule to the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after the passage "£5 5s." the words "or such other amount as is from time to time prescribed by regulation".
