## No. 1241.

An Act to amend the Shearers Accommodation Act, 1905.

[Assented to, October 5th, 1916.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Shearers Accommodation Act Amendment Act, 1916". Short titles.

(2) The Shearers Accommodation Act, 1905, and this Act may be cited together as the "Shearers Accommodation Acts, 1905 and 1916". No. 887 of 1905.

**2.** This Act is incorporated with the Shearers Accommodation Act, 1905, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with Act 887, 1905.

**3.** Section 7 of the Shearers Accommodation Act, 1905, is amended by striking out the word "and" at the end of subsection (c) thereof and adding at the end of the said section the following subsections:— Amendment of Act 887, 1905, s. 7—  
What is proper and sufficient accommodation.

(e) Each kitchen and each sleeping and dining room shall be supplied with sufficient light and ventilation, and shall be cleaned and fumigated or disinfected at least once in each year to the approval of an inspector, on or before a date to be decided by him: Qld. 30, 1915, s. 6 (2).

(f) Each kitchen and each sleeping and dining room shall be provided with a floor of suitable material, to the approval of an inspector:

(g) A meat house or meat safe, properly constructed, shall be provided, to the approval of an inspector:

(h) A sufficient supply of good drinking water shall be provided:

(i) Proper cooking, drinking, and washing vessels and utensils shall be provided; and

(j) All such buildings as referred to in section 6 shall be distant at least fifty yards from the shearing shed: Provided that buildings erected prior to the passing of this Act at a distance from the shearing shed less than fifty yards, which contain, or which are altered so as to contain, the accommodation required by this Act, and which are recommended by an inspector and approved by the Minister, shall be deemed to comply with the requirements of this subsection.
