### No. 12 of 1979

An Act to amend the South Australian Heritage Act, 1978.

[Assented to 8th March, 1979]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Heritage Act Amendment Act, 1979". Short titles.

(2) The South Australian Heritage Act, 1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Heritage Act, 1978-1979".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the definition of "Item" and inserting in lieu thereof the following definition:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—  
Definitions.

"Item" means—

(a) any land, building or structure;

or

(b) any shipwreck lying in the territorial waters of the State:.
