No. 107 of 1969**An Act to amend the South Australian Railways
Commissioner's Act, 1936-1965.**

[Assented to 18th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act Amendment Act, 1969".

(2) The South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1969".

(3) The South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of
principal Act,
s. 5—
Interpretation.

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the definition of "branch" the following definition :—

"liquor" means liquor as defined in the Licensing Act, 1967-1969 ; ;

and

(b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection :—

(3) Any amendments that might have been made to this Act by the Licensing Act, 1967, are hereby cancelled and this Act shall be read and construed as if that Act had had no effect whatsoever upon the text or validity of any provision of this Act.

3. Section 102 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "Licensing Act, 1932" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Licensing Act, 1967-1969".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 102—
Commissioner may supply liquor at refreshment rooms without licence.

4. Section 103 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "Early Closing Acts, 1911 to 1924" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Early Closing Act, 1926-1960".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 103—
Early Closing Act does not apply.

5. Section 104 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "Part V of the Licensing Act, 1932, may sell or supply any liquor as defined by section 4 of the Licensing Act, 1932" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Part IV of the Licensing Act, 1967-1969, may sell or supply liquor".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 104—
Sale of liquor at refreshment rooms and on trains.

6. Section 105 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place :—

Repeal of s. 105 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place—

105. The Commissioner may, at the railway refreshment rooms at the Adelaide Railway Station, without obtaining any licence or permit, sell or supply, subject to the appropriate by-laws made pursuant to this Act, liquor for consumption within those refreshment rooms to any person between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and ten o'clock in the evening on any day except Sunday or Good Friday.

Sale of liquor at Adelaide Railway Station.

7. Section 133 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (b) the following paragraph :—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 133—
By-laws.

(ba) Providing that any provisions of the Licensing Act, 1967-1969, (including provisions as to penalties) shall apply (without however creating or expanding any rights to sell, supply or consume liquor beyond

those established under this Act), *mutatis mutandis* and with such modifications as may be prescribed in the by-laws, to and in relation to the sale, supply or consumption of liquor at any railway refreshment rooms at which the Commissioner sells or supplies liquor and making such further provision in relation thereto as may be prescribed in the by-laws :.
