An Act to amend the South Australian Railways Commissioners Acts, 1887 to 1921, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 16th, 1926.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioners Act Further Amendment Act, 1926." Short titles.

(2) The South Australian Railways Commissioners Acts, 1887 to 1921, and this Act may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioners Acts, 1887 to 1926."

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. In addition to any other powers conferred upon the Commissioner, the Commissioner may purchase, construct, or otherwise acquire any motor or other vehicles, and may use and maintain the same for the purpose of conveying passengers and goods on the roads and streets in the State. Power to use motor vehicles.

4. Section 16 of the South Australian Railways Commissioners Act Further Amendment Act, 1921, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :—

(3) For the purpose of this section, "tramcar" shall be deemed to include any vehicle of the Commissioner used for the purpose of conveying passengers on any road or street in the State.
