## No. 19 of 1975

An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901, as amended; the Audit Act, 1921, as amended; the Police Regulation Act, 1952, as amended; the Public Service Act, 1967, as amended; the Public Service Arbitration Act, 1968, as amended; the Valuation of Land Act, 1971, as amended, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 27th March, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

### PART I PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1974-1975". Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

**PART II**  
**AMENDMENT OF AGENT-GENERAL ACT**

Short titles.

4. (1) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1973, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Agent-General Act, 1901-1975".

Repeal of s. 5 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place.

5. Section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Salary and allowances of Agent-General.

5. (1) The Agent-General shall be paid such salary and allowances as the Governor may from time to time determine.

(2) A determination made under subsection (1) of this section may be expressed to take effect on a day that occurs before the day on which the determination is made.

(3) The salary and allowances referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be a charge on the General Revenue of the State which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.

**PART III**  
**AMENDMENT OF AUDIT ACT**

Short titles.

6. (1) The Audit Act, 1921-1973, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Audit Act, 1921-1975".

Repeal of s. 6 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place—

7. Section 6 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Salary of Auditor-General.

6. (1) The Auditor-General shall be paid such salary and allowances as the Governor may from time to time determine.

(2) A determination made under subsection (1) of this section may be expressed to take effect on a day that occurs before the day on which the determination is made.

(3) The salary and allowances referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be a charge on the General Revenue of the State which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.

**PART IV**  
**AMENDMENT OF POLICE REGULATION ACT**

Short titles.

8. (1) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1973, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act, 1952-1975".

9. Section 8 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Repeal of s. 8 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place—  
Salary of Commissioner.

8. (1) The Commissioner of Police shall be paid such salary and allowances as the Governor may from time to time determine.

(2) A determination under subsection (1) of this section may be expressed to take effect on a day that occurs before the day on which the determination is made.

(3) The salary and allowances referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be a charge on the General Revenue of the State which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.

## PART V

### AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE ACT

10. (1) The Public Service Act, 1967-1975, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act". Short titles.

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1967-1975".

11. Section 15 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Repeal of s. 15 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place—

15. (1) The Commissioner nominated as Chairman of the Board and each of the other Commissioners shall be paid respectively such salaries and allowances as the Governor may from time to time determine.

Salaries and allowances of Chairman and Commissioners.

(2) A determination under subsection (1) of this section may be expressed to take effect on a day that occurs before the day on which the determination is made.

(3) The salaries and allowances referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be a charge on the General Revenue of the State which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.

## PART VI

### AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE ARBITRATION ACT

12. (1) The Public Service Arbitration Act, 1968-1970, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act". Short titles.

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Public Service Arbitration Act, 1968-1975".

13. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage “As from and including the first day of January, 1970, the Arbitrator shall be paid a salary at the rate of fourteen thousand four hundred and twenty dollars per annum,” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “The Arbitrator shall be paid such salary as the Governor may from time to time determine,”;

and

(b) by inserting immediately after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

(1a) A determination under subsection (1) of this section may be expressed to take effect on a day which occurs before the day on which the determination is made.

PART VII

AMENDMENT OF VALUATION OF LAND ACT

Short titles.

14. (1) The Valuation of Land Act, 1971-1973, is in this Part referred to as “the principal Act”.

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the “Valuation of Land Act, 1971-1975”.

15. Section 8 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

Salary of  
Valuer-  
General.

8. (1) The Valuer-General shall be paid such salary as the Governor may from time to time determine.

(2) A determination under subsection (1) of this section may be expressed to come into effect on a day that occurs before the day on which the determination is made.

(3) The salary referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be a charge on the General Revenue of the State which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.
