**No. 52 of 1963**

An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934-1961, the Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1958, and the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1960, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 28th November, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act (No. 2), 1963". Short titles.

2. Subsection (3) of section 55 of the Constitution Act, 1934-1961, is amended by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty pounds" and "one hundred and twenty-five pounds" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "three hundred pounds" and "two hundred pounds" respectively. 3. Subsection (3) of section 65 of the Constitution Act, 1934-1961, is amended— Amendment of Constitution Act, 1934-1961, s. 65 (3).

- (a) by striking out the words "seventeen thousand and fifty pounds" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "nineteen thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds";
- (b) by striking out the passage "1948-1958" at the end thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "1948-1963".

**4.** The Constitution Act, 1934-1961, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1963".

**5.** Section 4 of the Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1958, as amended by the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1960, is amended—

- (a) by striking out the words "two thousand pounds" in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "two thousand five hundred pounds";
- (b) by striking out the words "five hundred and fifty pounds" in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "six hundred pounds";
- (c) by striking out the words "seven hundred pounds" in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "eight hundred pounds";
- (d) by striking out the words "eight hundred pounds" in paragraph (c) of subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "nine hundred and fifty pounds";
- (e) by striking out the words "five hundred and fifty pounds" in subsection (3) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "six hundred pounds".

**6.** Section 5 of the Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1958, as amended by the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1960, is amended by striking out all the words figures and symbols commencing with the words "Leader of the Opposition" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the following passage :—

Leader of the Opposition, House of Assembly	One thousand and fifty pounds plus an allowance of £300 in respect of expenses
Deputy Leader of the Oppo- sition, House of Assembly	Four hundred pounds
Government Whip, House of Assembly	Three hundred pounds
Opposition Whip, House of Assembly	Three hundred pounds
Leader of the Opposition, Legislative Council	An allowance of £300 in respect of expenses

7. The Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1958, as amended by the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1960, and by this Act may be cited as the "Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1963".

8. The amendments made by this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, 1963.

9. The arrears of salary, allowance, payment or remuneration payable to any person by reason of the amendments made by this Act may be paid in one sum and this Act shall without further appropriation be sufficient authority for the payment of any such arrears.

10. (1) Paragraph (a) of section 5 of the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1960, is amended by inserting before the word "therein" in that paragraph the passage "first occurring".
