An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1953, the Audit Act, 1921-1957, the Industrial Code, 1920-1963, the Public Service Arbitration Act, 1961, the Police Regulation Act, 1952-1963, and the Public Service Act, 1936-1959, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1964".

Amendment of Salary of Agent-General.

2. Section 5 of the Agent-General Act, 1901-1953, as amended Agent-General Act, 1901-1953, as amended Agent-General Act, 1901-1953, as amended Act, 1901-1953, from time to time, is amended by striking out the words "four a time to time, is amended by striking out the words "four a time." thousand" in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "four thousand and fifty-two".

Amendment of Audit Act, 1921-1957 s. 6— Salary of Auditor-General,

3. Section 6 of the Audit Act, 1921-1957, as amended from time to time, is amended by striking out the words "five thousand one hundred and fifty" in subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "five thousand two hundred and two".

4. Section 13 of the Industrial Code, 1920-1963, as amended Amendment of Industrial from time to time, is amended—

Code, 1920-1963, s. 13-Salary of President and Deputy President.

- (a) by striking out the words "five thousand" in subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "five thousand and fifty-two"; and
- (b) by striking out the words "four thousand two hundred and fifty" in subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "four thousand three hundred and two".
- 5. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Public Service Arbitration Amendment of Public Service Act, 1961, as amended from time to time, is amended by striking out the symbol and figures "£4,800" (twice occurring) therein s. 4 (1)and inserting in lieu thereof the symbol and figures "£4,852" in each case.

Salary of Public Service Arbitrator.

1952-1963, as amended from time to time, is amended by striking out the words "four thousand eight hundred" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "four thousand signal and fifty-two".

7. Section 17 of the Public Service Act, 1936-1959, as amended from time to time, is amended by striking out the Act, 1936-1959, words "five thousand one hundred and fifty" in subsection (1) s. 17—Salary of thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "five thousand Commissioner. two hundred and two".

8. The rates of salary fixed by sections 2 to 7 (inclusive) of Operation of Increases in this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the salaries. twenty-second day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

- 9. (1) The arrears of salary payable to any person by virtue Attears. of this Act may be paid in one sum.
- (2) This Act shall, without further appropriation, be sufficient authority for the payment of all such arrears.
