An Act to amend the State Bank Acts, 1925 to 1935.

[Assented to, 26th November, 1936.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Bank Act Amendment Act, 1936". Short titles.

(2) The State Bank Acts, 1925 to 1935, and this Act may be cited together as the "State Bank Acts, 1925 to 1936".

(3) The State Bank Act, 1925, is in this Act called "the principal Act". 1703, 1925.

2. This Act is incorporated with the State Bank Acts, 1925 to 1935, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 76F of the principal Act (as enacted by section 4 of the State Bank Act Amendment Act, 1935) is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "or of a lease or agreement for sale of lands of the Crown granted or made by or on behalf of the Crown". Amendment of principal Act, s. 76F— Security for advances under Part VIA.

4. Section 76G of the principal Act (as enacted by section 4 of the State Bank Act Amendment Act, 1935) is amended by inserting at the end of paragraph (a) thereof the following:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 76G

Provided that where the security is an interest in land other than the fee simple no advance shall exceed one half of the value of that interest determined as aforesaid.
