An Act to amend the State Bank Act, 1925-1941.

[Assented to 23rd December, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Bank Act short titles. Amendment Act, 1954".
- (2) The State Bank Act, 1925-1941, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "State Bank Act, 1925-1954".
- (3) The State Bank Act, 1925-1941, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
 - 3. Section 19 of the principal Act is amended—
- Amendment of s. 19 of principal Act
- (a) by striking out the figures "1916" in the fourth line Appointment of officers. of subsection (2) and inserting in lieu thereof "1936-1953";
- (b) by striking out the words "Classification and Efficiency" in the sixth and seventh lines of subsection (2).
- 4. Section 20 of the principal Act is repealed.

s, 20 of principal Act-

Amendment of s. 76j of principal Act— Repayment of advances with interest. 5. Section 76j of the principal Act is amended by striking out all words in the said section after the word "interest" first occurring in the second line thereof.

Repeal of s. 78 of principal Act and enactment of other provisions— Insurance.

- 6. Section 78 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—
 - 78. (1) Where any person to whom the bank has made a loan on the security of land is obliged or desires to insure any building, erection or improvement on such land against any risk the bank may—
 - (a) underwrite such insurance;
 - (b) charge reasonable premiums therefor and fix the times for payment of such premiums.
 - (2) The bank when underwriting any such insurance shall be deemed to be an insurance company or an insurer within the meaning of any Act, covenant or agreement requiring such insurance.
