An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act,
1936-1951.

[Assented to 11th November, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1954". Short titles.

(2) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1951, as amended
by this Act, may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act,
1936-1954".

(3) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1951, is hereinafter
referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking
out the word "fifteen" in the last line of subsection (3) thereof
and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty". Amendment of

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the word "tuberculosis" in the second
line of paragraph (b) of subsection (4) thereof
and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "disease";

(b) by adding at the end of paragraph (d) of subsection (4)
thereof the word "or";

(c) by adding at the end of subsection (4) thereof the following paragraph :—

(e) where the owner of any pig has failed to carry out any instruction in writing given to the owner by an inspector for the control or eradication of any disease in the piggery of the owner and the chief inspector is satisfied that the pig has died or has been destroyed because of that disease as a result of that failure.

4. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out the words “ ten shillings or part of ten shillings ” in the first line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “ one pound or part of one pound ” ;
- (b) by striking out the words “ one penny ” in the sixth line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “ one and a half pence ” ;
- (c) by striking out the words “ five shillings ” in the last line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “ three shillings and nine pence ” .
