No. 53 of 1980**An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1978.***[Assented to 3rd July, 1980]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1980".

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1980".

Amendment of
principal Act,
s. 13a—
Retirement of
judges, etc.

2. Section 13a of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) A judge shall retire on reaching the age of seventy years.;

and

(b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) A judge who retires on reaching the age of seventy years, or who resigns before reaching that age, may nevertheless complete the hearing and determination of any proceedings part-heard by him before his retirement or resignation and, in relation to any such proceedings, shall be deemed to continue as a judge.
