An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1975.

[Assented to 26th October, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1978". Short titles.

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1978".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 33 of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of s. 33 of principal Act.

4. Sections 115 and 116 of the principal Act are repealed.

Repeal of ss. 115 and 116 of principal Act.
