An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1947.

[Assented to 6th September, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1951".

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1935-1951".

(3) The Supreme Court Ačt, 1935-1947, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 12— Salaries of judges.

- **3.** Section 12 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by inserting after the words "three thousand" in the second line of subsection (1) the words "seven hundred and fifty";
 - (b) by striking out the words "two thousand five hundred" at the end of the third line of subsection (1) and inserting in their place "three thousand two hundred and fifty".

4. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on Commencement of Act. the first day of July nineteen hundred and fifty-one.
