An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1947.

[Assented to 6th September, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

- Short titles.** **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1951".
- (2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1935-1951".
- (3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1947, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- Incorporation.** **2.** This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- Amendment of principal Act, s. 12—**
Salaries of judges. **3.** Section 12 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting after the words "three thousand" in the second line of subsection (1) the words "seven hundred and fifty";
- (b) by striking out the words "two thousand five hundred" at the end of the third line of subsection (1) and inserting in their place "three thousand two hundred and fifty".
