An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1966.

[Assented to 30th March, 1967.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1967".

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1967".

(3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of

3. Section 13e of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection (the whole of the preceding provisions of the section being redesignated as subsection (1) thereof) :—

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act any pension which is payable in accordance with this Act to a retired judge shall be increased from the first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven by such amount as is necessary to raise it to the rate of six thousand two hundred and fifty dollars per annum, and any pension which is payable in accordance with this Act to the widow of a deceased judge shall be increased from

the first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven by such amount as is necessary to raise it to a rate of three thousand one hundred and twenty-five dollars per annum.
