An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act 1935.

[Assented to 11 March 1999]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court (Rules of Court) Amendment Act 1999.
- (2) The Supreme Court Act 1935 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 72—Rules of court

- 3. Section 72 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph II of subsection (1) the following paragraph:
 - IIaa. For imposing mutual obligations on parties to proceedings in the court to disclose to each other the contents of expert reports or other material of relevance to the proceedings before the proceedings are brought to trial:
