An Act to amend the Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1956.

[Assented to 19th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1959". Short titles.

(2) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1956, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1959".

(3) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1956, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the principal Act is amended— Amendment of principal Act, s. 5— Interpretation.

(a) by inserting before the interpretation of "camel" the following interpretation :—

"animal product" means and includes meat, fat, milk, whey, cream, butter, cheese, eggs, or semen of any stock :

(b) by inserting in the interpretation of "carcass" after the word "hoofs" therein, the words "feathers, blood, viscera," ;

(c) by inserting after paragraph (c) in the interpretation of "stock" therein the following new paragraph :—

(d) Any animal product of any stock as hereinbefore defined :
