### No. 2119.

An Act to amend the Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1930.

[Assented to, November 2nd, 1933.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1933". Short titles.
  - (2) The Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1930, and this Act may be cited together as the "Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1933".
  - (3) The Succession Duties Act, 1929, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1898 of 1929.
2. Section 42 of the principal Act (as amended by section 2 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1929, by section 9 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1930, and by section 5 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1932) is amended by striking out the word "thirty-four" therein and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-five". Amendment of principal Act, s. 42—  
Continuance of increased duties for a further year.
  3. Section 55 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "three and a half" in the fifth and sixth lines thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "four pounds". Amendment of principal Act, s. 55—  
Interest on over-payments of duty.
