An Act to amend the Succession Duties Acts,
1929 to 1933.

[*Assented to, November 29th, 1934.*]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1934". Short titles.

(2) The Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1933, and this Act may be cited together as the "Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1934".

(3) The Succession Duties Act, 1929, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1898 of 1929.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after the definition of "settlement" the following definition :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 4— Interpretation.

"testamentary expenses" means any expenses incurred in obtaining administration of any property of a deceased person by an administrator, and in vesting in the administrator the property to which the administration relates :

3. Section 42 of the principal Act (as amended by section 2 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1929, by section 9 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1930, by section Amendment of principal Act, s. 42— Continuance of increased duties for a further year.

5 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1932, and by section 2 of the Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1933) is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection :—

(2) Where duty becomes chargeable on any property between the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty-five, and the first day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, the amount of duty payable shall be increased by fifteen per centum of the amount which would be payable except for the operation of this section.

4. Section 56 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "three and a half" in the eighth line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "four pounds".
