An Act to amend the Succession Duties Acts,
1929 to 1934.

[Assented to, 12th December, 1935.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Succession Duties Act Short titles.
Amendment Act, 1935".

(2) The Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1934, and this Act
may be cited together as the "Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to
1935".

(3) The Succession Duties Act, 1929, is hereinafter referred No. 1898 of
to as "the principal Act". 1929.

2. Section 42 of the principal Act is further amended by Amendment of
adding at the end thereof the following subsection :— principal Act,
s. 42—

(3) When duty becomes chargeable on any property
between the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and
thirty-six, and the first day of October, nineteen hundred
and thirty-six, the amount of duty shall be increased
by fifteen per centum of the amount which would be
payable except for the operation of this section.
