An Act to amend the Stock Diseases Act, 1934.

[Assented to 16 April 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1987".

(2) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 9—
Power of Governor to appoint inspectors and other persons.

2. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsection:

(2) The Deputy Chief Inspector has, while acting in the absence of the Chief Inspector, all the powers, duties and functions of the Chief Inspector under this and any other Act.
