## No. 89 of 1978

An Act to amend the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1978.

[Assented to 30th November, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Stamp Duties Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1978".

(2) The Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1978".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of second schedule of principal Act. 3. The second schedule to the principal Act is amended by striking out from *Exemption* No. 8 in division (B) of the item commencing "APPLICATION to Register a Motor Vehicle" paragraphs (b) and (c) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—

and

(b) that he is entitled as the holder of—

(i) a State Concession Card issued by the Department of Community Welfare;

or

(ii) a pensioner entitlement card issued under any Act or law of the Commonwealth,

to travel on public transport in this State at reduced fares.
