An Act to amend the Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1949.

[Assented to 30th November, 1950.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers Act Amendment Act, 1950".

(2) The Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1949, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1950".

(3) The Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1949, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, a. 9a---Renewal of licences.

2. Section 9a of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after subsection (7) thereof the following subsection :-

(8) If at least twenty-eight days before the thirty-first day of December in any year, a licensee gives notice in accordance with subsection (1) of his intention to apply for the renewal of his licence but the application for the renewal is not determined on or before such thirty-first day of December, the licence shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Act, be deemed to be extended until the application is disposed of by the court in accordance with this Act.
