An Act to amend the Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1964.

[Assented to 21st October, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers Act Amendment Act, 1971".
- (2) The Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1964, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1971".
- (3) The Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 17—
Hours of business.

- 2. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "A" being the first word in the subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Subject to subsection (1a) of this section, a":
  - (b) by striking out from subparagraph 1 of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "the Early Closing Act, 1926" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Part XV of the Industrial Code, 1967-1970";

- (c) by striking out subparagraph II of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—
  - if his premises are not a shop to which that Part applies, during the hours when shops in the locality, in which his premises are situated, are open for business.;

and

- (d) by inserting immediately after subsection (1) the following subsection:—
  - (1a) It shall not be a contravention of this section for a licensee to buy or sell second-hand goods, not being a motor vehicle as defined for the purposes of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1971, on any Sunday or public holiday at his premises where those premises are situated outside a shopping district as defined for the purposes of the Industrial Code, 1967-1970.
