An Act to amend the State Lotteries Act, 1966.

[Assented to 22 December 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Lotteries Act Amendment Act, 1983". Short title.

(2) The State Lotteries Act, 1966, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsections:

Amendment of s. 17—  
Percentage of value of tickets to be offered as prizes.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), the Commission may offer as prizes in a lottery less than sixty per centum of the value of the tickets offered for sale in the lottery but, if it does so, a portion of the moneys received by the Commission equal to the difference between the value of those prizes and sixty per centum of the value of those tickets shall be applied for the purpose of additional or increased prizes in a subsequent lottery or lotteries conducted by the Commission.

(3) In determining, in relation to a lottery, whether an amount is to be applied in pursuance of subsection (2) for the purpose of additional or increased prizes in a subsequent lottery or lotteries, any amount applied for the purpose of additional or increased prizes in that firstmentioned lottery, pursuant to subsection (2), shall be disregarded.
