An Act to amend the Mental Health (Supplementary Provisions) Act, 1935-1979, and the Workers Compensation Act, 1971-1982.

[Assented to 16 June 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statute Law Revision Act, 1983".

Short title.

2. (1) The Acts specified in the first column of the schedule to this Act are amended in the manner indicated in the second column of the schedule, and an Act as so amended may be cited by the citation specified in respect of that Act in the third column of the schedule.

Amendment of Acts specified in the schedule.

(2) If an Act sought to be amended by this Act is, before the commencement of this Act, amended in a manner that renders an amendment sought by this Act ineffective, the amendment sought by this Act shall be deemed to have been struck out.
