## No. 36 of 1952.

An Act to enable the State to grant certain lands and materials to the Commonwealth for the construction, maintenance, or working of the railway between Stirling North and Brachina.

[Assented to 27th November, 1952.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Stirling North to Brachina Railway (Land and Materials) Act, 1952 ”. Short title.

2. In this Act “ the railway ” means the railway being constructed by the Commonwealth between Stirling North and Brachina. Interpretation.

3. (1) The Governor may grant to the Commonwealth free of charge— Power to grant land.

(a) any Crown lands not subject to a lease ; or

(b) any leased lands of the Crown in respect of which the Commonwealth shall have acquired the rights of the lessees—

if the Commonwealth Railways Commissioner certifies that such lands are required by the Commonwealth in connection with the construction, maintenance, or working of the railway.

(2) The Minister of Lands may grant to the Commonwealth free of charge any stone, soil, and gravel upon any Crown lands

(including leased land of the Crown) from which the State or any Minister or authority representing the State has the right to take such stone, soil and gravel, if the Commonwealth Railways Commissioner certifies that such stone, soil and gravel is required by the Commonwealth in connection with the construction, maintenance, or working of the railway.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
