An Act to amend the Summary Offences Act, 1953.

[Assented to 29 October 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Summary Offences Act Amendment Act, 1987". Short title.

(2) The Summary Offences Act, 1953, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 73 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted: Repeal of s. 73 and substitution of new section.

73. (1) A member of the police force may enter a place of public entertainment and— Power of police to remove disorderly persons from places of public entertainment.

(a) order any person who is behaving in a disorderly or offensive manner to leave;

or

(b) use reasonable force to remove any person who is behaving in such a manner.

(2) A person—

(a) who remains in a place of public entertainment after having been ordered to leave pursuant to this section;

or

(b) who re-enters, or attempts to re-enter, a place of public entertainment within 24 hours of having left or having been removed from such a place pursuant to this section,

is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: \$2 000 or imprisonment for 6 months.
