An Act to amend the Summary Offences Act, 1953.

[Assented to 29 October 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Summary Offences Act Amendment Short title. Act, 1987".
- (2) The Summary Offences Act, 1953, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. Section 73 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section Repeal of s. 73 and substitution of new section. is substituted:

73. (1) A member of the police force may enter a place of public Power of police entertainment and-

(a) order any person who is behaving in a disorderly or offen- entertainment. sive manner to leave;

- (b) use reasonable force to remove any person who is behaving in such a manner.
- (2) A person—
 - (a) who remains in a place of public entertainment after having been ordered to leave pursuant to this section;

or

(b) who re-enters, or attempts to re-enter, a place of public entertainment within 24 hours of having left or having been removed from such a place pursuant to this section,

is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: \$2 000 or imprisonment for 6 months.
