An Act to amend the State Transport Authority Act, 1974-1978.

[Assented to 28th September, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Transport Authority Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1978".
- (2) The State Transport Authority Act, 1974-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "State Transport Authority Act, 1974-1978".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 7—
Terms and conditions upon which members hold office.

- 2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:—
 - (1a) The Governor may appoint—
 - (a) a member of the Authority;

(b) some other suitable person,

to be Deputy Chairman of the Authority.;

and

- (b) by striking out subsection (3) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (3) The Governor may appoint a suitable person to be a deputy of a member of the Authority (other than the Chairman) and such a person may act as a member of the Authority—
 - (a) in the case of the deputy of the member who is Deputy Chairman of the Authority—
 - (i) in the absence of the Deputy Chairman;

(ii) at any meeting of the Authority at which the Deputy Chairman presides;

or

- (b) in any other case—in the absence of the member of whom he has been appointed a deputy.
- 3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (4), both subsections designated as subsection (5) and subsection (6) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsections:—

 Meetings, quorum, etc., of the of the company of the co
- Authority.
 - (4) In the absence of the Chairman from a meeting of the Authority the Deputy Chairman shall, if present, preside at that meeting, and in the absence of both the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman from a meeting of the Authority, the members present shall choose one of their number to preside at that meeting.
 - (5) Each member of the Authority shall have one vote on any matter arising for determination by the Authority, and the person presiding at a meeting of the Authority shall, in the event of an equality of votes, have a second or casting vote.
 - (6) A decision carried by a majority of the votes cast by the members present at a meeting of the Authority shall be a decision of the Authority.
 - (7) The Authority shall cause accurate minutes to be kept of its meetings.
