An Act to amend the Taxation Acts, 1915 to 1920, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 7th, 1921.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Taxation Act Further Amendment Act, 1921." Short titles.

(2) The Taxation Acts, 1915 to 1920, and this Act may be cited together as the "Taxation Acts, 1915 to 1921."

2. Section 4 of the Taxation Act Further Amendment Act, 1919, is amended by adding at the end of subsection (2) thereof the passage "and in respect of income tax on income for the period of twelve months ended on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-one." Amendment of Act 1411, 1919, s. 4—
Super tax continued for year 1920-1921.
