An Act to amend the Transplantation and Anatomy Act, 1983.

[Assented to 6 June 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Transplantation and Anatomy Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The Transplantation and Anatomy Act, 1983, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Insertion of new s. 38a.

2. The following section is inserted after section 38 of the principal Act:

Offence to provide false or misleading information in relation to the donation of blood or semen.

38a. (1) A donor who supplies false or misleading information in relation to the donation of blood or semen, knowing the information to be false or misleading, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: \$10 000.

(2) In this section—

"donor" means a person who—

(i) donates blood for any use or purpose contemplated by this Act;

or

(ii) donates semen for the purposes of a fertilization procedure or for medical or scientific purposes:

“fertilization procedure” means—

(i) artificial insemination;

or

(ii) the procedure of fertilizing an ovum outside the body
and transferring the fertilized ovum into the uterus.
