An Act to vest a certain part of the Adelaide Gaol Reserve in the South Australian Railways Commissioner, and to place other part thereof under the care, control, and management of the Adelaide City Council.

[Assented to, September 27th, 1911.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Adelaide Gaol Reserve Alteration Act, 1911." Short title.

2. All that piece of land, being part of the Adelaide Gaol Reserve, delineated in the plan in the Schedule to this Act and therein hatched in black and marked A, is hereby vested in the South Australian Railways Commissioner for an estate of inheritance in fee simple for the purposes of "The South Australian Railway Commissioners Act, 1887," and the Acts amending that Act, or of any Act substituted for that Act. Part of Adelaide Gaol Reserve vested in Railways Commissioner.

3. All that piece of land, being other part of the said Reserve, delineated in the said plan and therein hatched in red and marked B, shall be under the care, control, and management of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Adelaide. Part of Reserve to be under care, control, and management of City Council.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
