An Act to incorporate Amendments in Reprints of Amended Acts.

[Assented to, September 24th, 1914.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Amendments Incorporation Short title. Act, 1914."
- 2. (1) When any Act has, before or after the passing of this Act, Incorporation of been amended by—

(a) the repeal or omission of certain words or figures, or

- (b) the substitution of certain words or figures in lieu of any words or figures struck out or repealed, or
- (c) the insertion or addition of certain words or figures, then, in any reprint of such Act by the Government Printer, such Act shall be printed as so amended.
- (2) In every reprint of an Act so amended, reference shall be made in the margin or in a footnote to the enactments by which the amendments were respectively made.
- (3) In this Act, the term "words" includes Part, Division, heading, section, subsection paragraph and subdivision of a section, Schedule, and every other passage in an Act.

## The Amendments Incorporation Act.—1914.

3. There shall be printed on every reprint issued by the Government Printer of any Act which has, before or after the passing of this Act, been amended, a short reference to every Act by which it has been amended.

Government Printer to act on certificate of Clerk of Parliaments. 4. The Government Printer shall not make any reprint in pursuance of this Act except upon a certificate in writing of the Clerk of Parliaments.
