An Act to amend The Election of Senators Act, 1903.

[Assented to 2nd March, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as "The Election of Senators Act Amendment Act, 1978". Short titles.

(2) The Election of Senators Act, 1903, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as "The Election of Senators Act, 1903-1978".

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "nine days" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "five days".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 2—
Governor to fix times and places for election of senators.
