An Act to amend "The Governor's Appropriation Act, 1911."

[Assented to, November 28th, 1912.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as "The Governor's Appropriation Act Amendment Act, 1912." Short titles.

(2) "The Governor's Appropriation Act, 1911" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as "The Governor's Appropriation Acts, 1911 and 1912." No. 1065 of 1911.

2. This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one Act, with the principal Act and all Acts with which that Act is incorporated. Incorporation with other Acts.

3. The money which the Governor is by the principal Act authorised to appropriate is herein referred to as "the Governor's Appropriation Fund." Meaning of "Governor's Appropriation Fund."

4. In case Parliament is not in Session at the beginning of a financial year, and the Governor, during such year and before the commencement of the first Session in such year, makes provision for the Public Service within the said State by appropriating money from the Governor's Appropriation Fund, then the money so appropriated may be recouped to the Governor's Appropriation Fund out of the money voted by any Supply Act or Acts for such year, to the intent that the Governor shall thereafter have power to appropriate revenue under the authority of the principal Act to the extent and for the purposes permitted by that Act: Further powers where Session commences after beginning of the financial year.

Provided

The Governor's Appropriation Act Amendment Act.—1912.

Provided that not more than a total amount of Fifty Thousand Pounds shall, in exercise of the powers conferred by the principal Act and this Act, be appropriated in any financial year except for purposes mentioned in the Estimates of Expenditure for such year, or, when such Estimates have not yet been laid on the table of the House of Assembly, for purposes mentioned in the Estimates of Expenditure for the next preceding financial year.

Act to be
retrospective.

5. The provisions of this Act shall have the same effect as if they had been contained in the principal Act on the passing thereof.
