An Act to further amend the "Bank Holidays Act, 1873,"
and the "Civil Service Act, 1874."

[Assented to, November 17th, 1909.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Holidays Act, 1909."

Short title.

2. The Act No. 251 of 1882 is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Act 251 of
1882.

3. After the passing of this Act, the "Bank Holidays Act,
1873," and the "Civil Service Act, 1874," shall be read as if those
Acts provided that the second Wednesday in October in every year
should be kept and observed as a bank holiday and a holiday in
the public offices.
