An Act to amend "The Health Act, 1898," and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 11th, 1909.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited alone as "The Health Act Amendment Short title. Act, 1909;" and this Act and "The Health Act, 1898" (hereafter in this Act called "the principal Act") may be cited together as "The Health Acts, 1898 and 1909."
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and the Incorporation with principal Act. principal Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. (1) Any sanitary rate declared under section 25 of the Provisions as to principal Act may be declared and levied and collected in respect principal Act. of the whole of the Municipality or District or any part or parts thereof, or in respect of any ward or wards or any part or parts thereof.

- (2) Any such sanitary rate may be expended for the purpose of How expended. the removal of nightsoil and for any other sanitary purposes, or for any of such purposes.
- (3) Where a rate has been so declared for sanitary purposes in respect of any area or areas being less than the whole of a municipality or district, the rate collected must be expended for the benefit of such area or areas only.

Sanitary expenses may be defrayed out of general revenue. 4. Any Municipal Council or District Council may, without declaring a sanitary rate, on the vote of an absolute majority of its members, undertake and carry out the removal of nightsoil and any other works and things for sanitary purposes, and defray the cost of so doing out of its general revenue.

Amendment of section 129 of principal Act. 5. Section 129 of the principal Act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:—

Fee to medical practitioner.

The Local Board shall pay to every medical practitioner a fee of Two Shillings for each report made by him to such Board under section 127 or section 128: Provided that when a report or reports is or are made concerning two or more persons in the same building only one such fee shall be payable.
